County Borough Council

- a. Parking PNV – Mr R Tyler from BBNP to give an update on the parking situation. The plan is to extend parking at Gwaun Hepste by 60 spaces. Signage is needed there and visitors need to know that they have to pay. Mr Tyler said that £25,000.00 has been given by the Welsh Assembly for consultants to hold a public meeting with residents. Cllr. Thomas said that a residents group was set up 2 years ago to discuss the problem so why are they wasting money on consultants when it could be spent on car parking.

Cllr Patrick asked why nothing has been done to increase parking at the Dinas Rock which was mentioned in a previous meeting. Cllr. Thomas also asked if BBNP have been talking to N & PTCC about the 50 extra spaces that were planned for the main PNV road. Cllr. Jones presented a petition from the residents of Bro Dawel asking for Residents Only Parking in their street.

Julian Atkins has still not supplied the information regarding why the amount awarded to PNV for parking was changed from £31,000.00 to £3000.00.

Mr Tyler will put another brief together and attend another meeting of the community Council.

- b. Residents Parking is being rolled out in problem areas in Powys. Public consultation is needed and 16 residents need to agree. Cllr. Thomas will recommend that PNV be considered. The petition from Bro Dawel will be given to the portfolio holder.
- c. There is no majority party in Powys CC at present.
- d. There is a news and views website for PNV which has been set up by a local resident. It was reported on there that more dog mess bins are needed in PNV. Residents of High Street refused to have one placed there.
- e. Recycling on Powys is a disaster at present. There is no funding for the centres to open 7 days.
