2018/42 Minutes

Cllr. Patrick read out the amended report as most of the mandatory determinations previously reported have now become discretionary. Determination 50 Reimbursement of necessary costs for care of dependent children and adults was adopted as it is mandatory.

Determination 47 reimbursement of travel costs was adopted.

2018/46 Dyfed Powys Police

P.C. Sara Richards and P.C.S.O. Nicole Watkins attended the meeting. They had contacted James Lawrence Tourist Officer BBNP regarding the parking issues at PNV on the recent bank holiday. There were complaints about drives being blocked and parking on double yellow lines. A local resident opened their field at Cwm Porth to help alleviate the problem there. P.C.S.O.'s do not work on bank holidays which causes a shortage of staff. P.C. Richards is hoping to have more joint patrols with South Wales Police. The BBNP parking project could take up to 2 years.

Slates were stolen off the old school in PNV. The owner is waiting for a bat survey before work can commence.

The Dragon Ride takes place on 10th June 2018, public notices will be sent out soon.

2018/47**County Borough Council**

- a. Bus Service - a circular tour was suggested for the new surgery. Cllr. Patrrick wrote to the practice manager who wrote to 1st Cymru but has had no response. It was decided that the council ask Glynneath Town Council, Resolven Community Council, Blaengwrach Community Council and Powys Health Board to support this suggestion.
- b. Nedd valley recycling - this issue has now been sorted.

- d. Cllr. Thomas reported that Powys CC are looking at the possibility of selling off some assets.
