2018/64 Minutes

The minutes were passed as a true record proposed by Cllr. Woodley and seconded by Cllr. Collins after amendment to 2018/60 (unable to respond to an anonymous letter).

2018/65 Declaration of Interest

2018/66 Dyfed Powys Police

Dyfed Powys Police sent apologies.

South Wales and Dyfed Powys Police have arranged a public meeting at Sgwd Gladys. There has been a breakdown in communication as the councillors and residents of PNV were not informed. Cllr. Cornish and Jones attended the meeting. N & PTCBC reported that they had no parking complaints since April, PNV residents were not aware that they could complain to N & PTCBC. Cllr. Cornish and Jones said they would attend the PACT meetings in Glynneath, Cllr. Woodley proposed that the community council agree to this.

2018/67 County Borough Council

- a. Repairs to Ty Mawr hill and pot holes in the area are now taking place.
- b. Powys CC are having consultations regarding blue badge holders being charged in car parks.
- c. Powys CC are also having consultation on over 16 pupils paying for school transport.
- d. There has been a 3.2 million underspend in Powys CC but they must make savings of 8.7 million this year.
- e. A refuse bin is needed at the top of Ty Mawr hill.

2018/69**Waterfalls Area Parking Plan**

Mr R Tyler BBNP presented the draft of the Waterfalls Area car parking plan.

Various areas have been marked out for each waterfall e.g. Penderyn Village - Sgwd Gladys Village Hall - Gunpowder Works etc. Clyngwyn barriers are in place on one side but parallel parking needs to be developed. More double yellow lines are needed outside the Angel on N&PTCBC side. More enforcement officers are needed in N & PT. The adopted road behind the Angel is blocked. We need to know how much of the car park at the Angel is owned by the pub and how much is public ground.

BBNP are talking to Powys CC about marking passing places to stop visitors parking in them. There is a residents parking proposal for some of PNV. BBNP are also in talks with Mr Horgan about using his field for parking under the 28 day rule. Local owners are already opening their fields for parking at Cwm Porth and the Show Field under the 28 day rule.

James Lawrence BBNP gave an update on what is happening in each area i.e. Gwaun Hepste, Cwm Porth, Comin yr Rhos, Penderyn etc.

Cllr. Thomas said that the plan is going to cost a lot of money. Mr Tyler said that they are now in a position to submit a grant application to Pen y Cymoedd for a feasibility study. The community council agreed to support the plan. Cllr. Reynolds thanked BBNP and Cllr. Thomas for all their work regarding the parking situation.

There will be a public meeting regarding the parking plan on 11th and 12th July 2018 between 3 - 8 p.m. in Ystradfellte and PNV and a press release in the Brecon & Radnor Express.

Ruth Coulthard BBNP is offering a site visit at the Gunpowder Works for the community council.
