Minutes of the meeting of Ystradfellte Community Council held at Ystradfellte Church Hall on 1st October 2018 at 7.00 p.m.

2018/84 Minutes

The minutes were passed as a true record proposed by Cllr. Woodley and seconded by Cllr. Reynolds

2018/85 Declaration of Interest

2018/89 Cllr. Woodley and Mrs Powell (Clerk) declared an interest as they live in the Hepste Valley.

2018/86 Dyfed Powys Police

P.C.S.O. Nash reported that there are 3 full time P.C.S.O.s in Ystradgynlais. There has not been no crime in the area recently. A burnt out car in Ystradfellte was not a stolen car. Parking in P.N.V. is still an issue. Cllr. Thomas is concerned about the parking situation when the Gunpowder Works open. The council asked that they be informed of any cross border meeting between N.&P.T.B.C. police and Dyfed Powys police

2018/87 County Borough Council

- a. There is a consultation at present for formula funding for schools.
- b. Powys CC budget - forecast underspend of 4.7 million and 21 million savings for next year.
- c. There is a pot hole near Tai Hirion farm.

2018/88 Matters Arising

- a. Parking PNV - see above
- b. Letters re PNV Village Hall - Cllr. Reynolds and Cllr. Collins attended a meeting with the village hall committee. They went through the questions asked in the letters, they were informed that the hall can be booked by residents. The committee has now increased by 2 residents. The accounts were presented to Cllr. Collins

2018/89**Dyfed I.T.**

Dyfed I.T. were invited to the meeting regarding 2 letters received from residents of the Nedd Valley regarding the broadband supply. Extra infrastructure is needed in the valley estimated at £1000.00 for the power system and £300.00 for the planning application. Dyfed I.T. said they would cover the cost of the planning application. The same cost would also be needed for the Hepste valley and the properties at Nant Cared, Ystradfellte.

Mr C. Evans (member of the public) asked whether the aerial fund held by the community council was only available for Ystradfellte and could it be used for the broadband cost. It was explained that the money was not ring fenced only to Ystradfellte. Mr S Wheeler (member of the public) asked about funding for the Nant Cared properties. The Hepste valley would also incur the same cost for the extra infrastructure. Cllr. Woodley and Mrs Powell declared an interest as they live in the Hepste valley and left the meeting. Cllr. Jones then took over minute taking.

It was agreed in principle that the aerial fund be used for assisting the supply of broadband to the areas that need extra infrastructure. A discussion took place and it was agreed that more information is needed regarding the Hepste valley i.e. how many properties would like broadband. The council need to be equitable to the whole of the community however at present there are only 3 areas who need funding. Information is needed for the next meeting. Dyfed I.T. have given a solution to 44 properties in the area to date.

Cllr. Jones will also look into what grants are available.

Cllr. Woodley and Mrs Powell returned to the meeting
