### **2020/4 County Borough Council**

- a. The budget has not yet been published, there is a 5.4% increase, teachers have had a 3% increase
- b. The 'Slow' sign near Tai Hirion has not been painted.
- c. Cllr. Thomas asked about recycling collections over Christmas as there had been lots of complaints. There were only 3 teams working instead of 6. He contacted the Cabinet member to lodge a complaint with the portfolio holder and waste manager.
