### County Borough Council

Cllr. Thomas reported that some Powys CC services will not be carried as usual during the corona virus pandemic, there are 500 staff off at present. There is a business crisis plan in place. Key services i.e. children and adult services, waste and recycling collections are operating. Some staff have volunteered to work in other services. The budget has gone out of the window as the council are losing 3.5 million per month as there is no car park income etc. There is a finance meeting being held this week.

A landslip has occurred behind the Angel Hotel and there is a tree down and overhanging rocks. As this is in N & PTCBC a letter will be sent to Glynneath Town Council.

It was reported that lots of people are walking up to the Gunpowder works, NRW have closed off the Rock area but BBNP are unable to close the access to the Gunpowder works due to the access to private properties in that area. Visitors have come to second homes in PNV, they need to be stopped before they actually arrive in the area.
