Eleanor Flaherty BBNPA attended the meeting to give an update on visitors to the area on the weekend. She reported that it had been a very challenging weekend with visitors entering the area. All wardens had been deployed to the Waterfalls Area, Dyfed Powys Police did not have enough resources but they deployed as many officers as they could. Notices were pulled down and residents were threatened when they challenged visitors. Cllr Thomas had an email regarding gangs of youngsters drinking in the area. Ms Flaherty asked that residents report to her and not to get involved as some of the visitors can be abusive. There will be no organised groups allowed into the area until possibly September.

BBNPA have no plans to open yet, N & PTCBC are starting to open parks. The parking spaces on their side of PNV were open. Sgwd Gladys was closed due to a landslide. A meeting is being held this week to discuss easing lockdown. Dyfed Powys Police and BBNPA are working together but it requires a lot of manpower to police the area.
