### 2020/67 Minutes

### 2020/69 Dyfed Powys Police

There have been several quad bikes stolen from the Hay area. There are a lot of telephone scams going around at present.

### 2020/70 County Borough Council

Cllr. Thomas reported that the deficit in Powys CC is looking slightly better at present as the Welsh Government have covered some costs during the pandemic. At the moment so many Powys CC staff are isolating that only critical services are being dealt with. There were some concerns from residents regarding licensed premises in the local lockdowns. Cllr. Thomas said the proprietors have been spoken to but if any more concerns arise report them to him immediately.

There was a query over a portable hot food van in the N & PTCBC area to be sited just below the BBNP toilets. Cllr. Thomas will express his concerns regarding the impact on parking. Cllr. Reynolds reported that Glynneath Town Council have not been informed of the application although it is on N & PTCBC's website. Cllr. Jones was concerned about the proximity to the toilets.

- a. Cllr. Jones reported that local people are not interested in buying old council houses in the area. One has been up for sale for over a year.
- b. Cllr. Jones asked about some licensed premises in the area who were saying they were in N & PTCBC but they are actually in Powys.
- c. Dinas Rock Bridge – this has now been repaired, it is in the RCT area therefore it comes under a local lockdown.
- d. Do PNV Covid numbers come under Powys or N&PTCBC – Powys.
