2020/85 Minutes

The minutes were passed as a true record proposed by Cllr. Patrick and seconded by Cllr. Woodley

2020/86 Declaration of Interest

None recorded

2020/87 Dyfed Powys Police

Not present. They sent an update regarding scam emails and the theft of quads and farm machinery.

A serious accident occurred recently in Dinas Road. There were no injuries but both cars were written off. The police did not attend. Cllr. Thomas had some emails regarding concerns with road markings, Highways will assess this. Are the speed regulations visible enough? Cllr. Thomas is dealing with a lot of queries at the moment in all areas. The investigation is down to the police not the local authority. Welsh Government will be trialling urban areas that are now 30 m.p.h. to 20 m.p.h. but it will need significant funding. Cllr. Jones reported that the vegetation needs cutting back as it is covering the yellow lines.

2020/88 County Borough Council

- b. Powys CC Budget has been delayed, the final settlement will be approved on 22nd December, there will not be a lot of extra money coming into Wales. A budget simulator is available online for the public from 9th December.
