### 2021/13 County Borough Council

Cllr. Thomas reported that the budget has been accepted by the cabinet and full council will meet on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2021. The proposed increase in council tax is 3.9%. There will be cuts in Highway Services/Maintenance, Play Areas, Countryside Access and Arts services. There is the possibility of 4 weekly waste collection. Cllr. Patrick asked if Powys CC are reducing face to face meetings. Cllr. Thomas said this could also be a possibility, this would save travelling expenses but could be detrimental in other ways.

- a. A resident has complained about water holding above Gwaun Hepste which is dangerous when icy They thought it might be due to some work by NRW but they have not done any work in the area since 2005. The new Highway Inspector David Lewis will go over to have a look.
- b. Cllr. Thomas reported on the sink holes that have opened near Goitre Farm, Ystradfellte. The road is closed for repairs.
