## Ystradfellte Community Council

Minutes of the meeting of Ystradfellte Community Council held remotely on 12<sup>th</sup> April 2021 at 7.00 p.m.

### **2021/28** **Minutes**

The minutes were passed as a true record proposed by Cllr. Patrick and seconded by Cllr. Bowman

### **2021/29** **Declaration of Interest**

None recorded

### **2021/31** **Dyfed Powys Police**

P.C. Sara Richards has been on sick leave and is now back on restricted duties. She was unable to attend this meeting.

Cllr. Bowman has spoken to a P.C.S.O. who did not have anything to report but said the police are gearing up for an increase in visitors to the area in the next few months.

### **2021/32** **County Borough Council**

Cllr. Thomas reported that Powys CC will maintain a normal refuse collection service over the Easter period. He said that a high volume of visitors will be a problem in the area in the next few months. BBNPA are reporting on social media when car parks are full.

There are 3 proposals for parking restrictions in the Waterfalls area in consultation with BBNPA. One of them being yellow lines from Porth yr Ogof junction down to Ystradfellte village. Cllr. Collins reported that last year cars were parked on the side of that road all the way down to the village.

- a. Water at Gwaun Hepste – Cllr. Thomas met with NRW who agreed to carry out some maintenance work there.
- b. Sink Holes Ystradfellte – no update
- c. Craig Y Dinas – the head of building control has assessed the roof and asked the owner to repair the roof. There is no danger to passers by, the work will be done in the next 2 months. Cllr. Collins reported that he had seen the owner doing some work, Cllr. Jones said very little has been done.
- d. Glan Mellte Bungalow – there have been complaints about the state of the property but as it is a private property there is nothing environmental health can do.

- e. Street Light – Powys CC have been replacing wooden poles with metal ones but have not put the lights back. Cllr. Thomas reported that Powys CC are now replacing all wooden posts with metal.
- f. There are a lot of pot holes on the Hepste Road. - done
- g. Has access been agreed for plots on the old school – Cllr. Thomas said it approved some years ago.
- h. There is a sink hole between the Vicarage and Garreg Fawr
- i. A new bin is needed for the Nedd valley, the old one is broken and dangerous.

- a. PNV Parking/Waterfall Country CIO – Cllr. Cornish gave an update. There will be a permanent warden in the Waterfalls area and a monitoring system in Cwm Porth car park. Market research people will be out and about in the next few weeks.
- b. Broadband Nedd Valley – Cllr. Collins has not yet had time to look into this. Cllr. Cornish will send him a link for Starlink.
