2021/42 Dyfed Powys Police

Cllr. Bowman has spoken to Dyfed Powys Police who reported that there has not been much happening in the area at present. They will be relying on BBNPA wardens to deal with the parking issues but will put more resources in the car parks when they are available.

There are a lot of scams at present targeting older people.

2021/43**County Borough Council**

- a. Street Light – Powys CC will replace the lantern shortly
- b. Pot holes Nedd Valley – done.
- c. Each property has their own wheelie bin, but a resident complained that he couldn't get all his rubbish in it. Extra recycling boxes can be ordered online.
- d. TRO Ystradfellte – a resident was not happy with the double yellow lines painted outside his property. There will be a full public consultation but it has been delayed at present.
- e. Powys CC are now beginning to relax some restrictions, and more services will be available. Lots of the council meetings will still be held remotely and lots of staff are still working from home.

2021/44**Matters Arising**

- a. PNV Parking/Waterfall Country CIO – It is in the process of being registered and the bank account is almost finalised. The projects are ready to go forward. The Pen y Cymoedd funding will be available in June.
- b. Broadband Nedd/Hepste Valley – Reece Collins Broadband Officer Powys CC attended the meeting to discuss government funding for areas that OpenReach are unable to connect. There are other companies who can provide broadband for rural areas. It will be a community led scheme and residents can apply to the Rural Voucher Scheme. After discussion Cllr. Woodley proposed that the community council adopt this scheme, seconded by Cllr. Collins. Mr Simmons will email a list of companies.
