Minutes of the meeting of Ystradfellte Community Council held at Ystradfellte Church Hall and remotely on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021 at 7.00 p.m.

### 2021/80 Minutes

### 2021/81 Declaration of Interest

2021/88 Cllr. Cornish and Bowman declared an interest and left the meeting.

### 2021/82 Dyfed Powys Police

P.C.S.O. Watkins has been speaking to Cllr. Bowman as there has been some trouble around the village hall but it was not reported. There has been a theft of sheep recently in the area. Cllr. Jones reported parking issues on the Powys and South Wales side of the village. Cllr. Bowman asked if the police have been informed of turkey farms as there may be a shortage this Christmas and there is a turkey farm in PNV. P.C.S.O. Watkins said she is hoping to do some work with farms in the next few weeks.

She agreed to chase up the Inspector's response to the complaint regarding reporting incidents to 101 reported at the last meeting as the community council have not yet received a reply.

### 2021/83 County Borough Council

- b. Covid cases are rising which is having an impact on Powys CC services as staff have been redeployed to other departments. Adult Social Care and Children's Services are under pressure. Highways are only doing essential repairs.

It was agreed to send another email asking that the community council be asked to all meetings. Cllr. Patrick proposed the email and Cllr. Collins seconded it.
