## Ystradfellte Community Council

Minutes of the meeting of Ystradfellte Community Council held at Ystradfellte Church Hall and remotely on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2021 at 7.00 p.m.

### 2021/91 Minutes

The minutes were passed as a true record proposed by Cllr. Patrick and seconded by Cllr. Woodley

### 2021/92 Declaration of Interest

2021/100 Cllr. Cornish and Bowman declared an interest and left the meeting.

2021/96 Cllr. Woodley declared an interest and left the meeting.

### 2021/93 Dyfed Powys Police

A reply has been received from Inspector Gwyndaf Bowen regarding the issue of a refusal to log a 101 call. He said that the performance manager at the operations room reported that if the issue is not overtly a police matter call handlers are trained not to record the incident but provide advice. P.C.S.O. Watkins apologised for misinformation. Cllr. Reynolds said that all 101 calls should be recorded. There is a Police and Crime Commissioner Survey at present, it could be asked what advice should be given to a 101 call if the road is gridlocked and emergency services need to get through. Cllr. Thomas said that an obstruction is an offence. Cllr. Bowman said that all 101 calls are recorded.

A suspicious transit van was reported in the area on the 7<sup>th</sup> October going around the farms asking for scrap metal. Also a VW Golf was reported on 14<sup>th</sup> October looking for a campsite

### 2021/94 County Borough Council

- a. Cllr. Thomas reported that the school re-organisation consultation was a capital spend concern.
- b. There is a new initiative for Powys residents over 60 to have free access to fitness suites.
- c. A new director of education has been appointed and an interim head of education.
- d. Powys Adult services and Children's services are still on critical services at present. There is a shortage of staff in Adult services.
- e. It was reported that 2664 people tested positive through track and trace.
- f. The drain on the high street should have been done.

- g. The residents of the cottages opposite the White Horse Pub have had letters from Powys CC to remove flower pots off the pavements, they will be liable if anyone has an accident. Also bollards should not be put outside houses for parking spaces. Cllr. Thomas said residents can write to him or the portfolio holder Cllr. Heulwen Hume.

**2021/95****Matters Arising**

- c. Invite to meetings concerning the community – reply from James Lawrence BBNPA stating that the community council will be invited to all meetings that have relevance to this area, Cllr. Bowman has also spoken to James Lawrence regarding this. Cllr. Reynolds said that as James Lawrence does not represent this area it should be the choice of the community council whether they attend meetings. Cllr. Cornish does not think that we do not need to attend all meetings. Cllr. Woodley said that the Waterfalls Partnership should have more meetings as we are not getting all the information. There is an invitation to meet the new CEO where this issue could be raised. Cllr. Thomas reported that a lot of people feel excluded, there is not enough local knowledge regarding the parking issues in this area although the warden service have a good relationship with residents. Cllr. Woodley said that the community council should be present when BBNPA have meetings with the police. Cllr. Reynolds proposed that we send another email to James Lawrence asking to be invited to all meetings this was seconded by Cllr. Patrick. A vote was taken 3 in agreement 2 abstained. An email will be sent to James Lawrence BBNPA.

Cllr. Cornish reported that there has been a proposal to work with Hirwaun and Penderyn Community Council on this project, she asked if anyone had an interest. Cllr. Woodley declared an interest as he is a councillor on this council and left the meeting. The project group have a meeting with Hirwaun and Penderyn CC next week, it was agreed to defer a decision until after this meeting.
