2022/36 Dyfed Powys Police

An email has been received from Chief Inspector G Bowen saying that the P.C.S.O.'s will work on Bank Holidays as and when they are needed. Cllr. Cornish proposed that we ask for all Bank Holidays to be covered, seconded by Cllr. Woodley. Cllr. Thomas reported that there may not be enforcement officers available due to Covid. There have been speed cameras in PNV lately. Cllr. Bowman will speak to South Wales Police.
