2016/22 County Borough Council

- a. Car Park PNV – Cllr. Thomas has spoken to Mr Horgan who is still on board with the car park project. John Cook has had an email saying that BBNP should be contacting N&PTCC officers direct. Mr Horgan will not apply for planning until the T.R.O.'s are in place. Cllr. Thomas has regular emails from the project manager of the gunpowder works project and he has been informed that some people are opposed to it.
- b. Flooding at Gwaun Hepste - some work will be done this week.
- c. Superfast Broadband – on going. Cllr. Woodley asked Cllr. Thomas if there was a charge for rural properties but Cllr. Thomas said that this was not true.
- d. Bin at Waun Blaedda - Cllr Collins is unsure if it has been placed there, he also said that the bins in the Nedd valley are overflowing, more bins are needed.
- e. Closure of Tourist Information Centres.- the landlord of the White Horse has enquired about the foyer of the pub being used for TIC displays. PNV Village hall has also offered to put a display up but this could add to the parking problems.
- f. A sink hole opened on Castle Hill, this has been attended to.
- g. Cllr. Thomas reported that Powys CC passed their budget last week, there will be a £11 million pounds of cuts. An increase of 4.25% in council tax set this week.

2016/23**Matters Arising**

- a. Cllr Patrick had a query from an Ystradfellte resident regarding superfast broadband, it should be available next summer.
- b. Cllr. Jones gave an update of the gunpowder works meeting on Saturday which some local residents attended. The project manager is having a meeting with N&PTCC regarding the parking issues and will inform Cllr. Jones of the outcome. Cllr. Jones said that the whole village should be consulted not just the people who have shown an interest.
- c. Llywelyn Bren - Cllr. Collins has been unable to contact the person in Bangor responsible. He has not yet had a price for the plaque.
